Self-Guided Tours for Groups

This tour allows teachers, students, and chaperones to tour the exhibition on their own during exhibition hours.

In-School Traveling Trunk Program

Two *Titanic* specialists will bring a *Titanic* Traveling Trunk to your classroom with various items to teach students about the *Titanic*. This would include an Artifact Specialist and one costumed actor (Violet Jessop, Margaret Brown, or Captain Smith).

Duration: 1 hour

Format: 40-min Traveling Trunk presentation with a 20-min Q&A session

Pricing: ■ \$200 for one classroom

Zoom presentation featuring a *Titanic* collections specialist, one of our *Titanic* actors, and a *Titanic* expert (scientist, oceanographer, submersible operator, or historian).

Duration: 35-50min

Format: 30-45min of presentations from our experts and the actor, followed by a 15min Q&A session (with questions submitted in advance from students)
